Dear business partners,

We would like to inform you that, as a result of the worldwide coronavirus epidemic (known as SARS CoV-2), the Government of the Czech Republic has declared a state of emergency. Therefore, as of March 14, the entry to the Czech Republic is forbidden for all foreigners coming from risk areas, with the exception of foreigners with permanent residence or temporary residence in the Czech Republic of over 90 days and foreigners whose entry is in the interest of the Czech Republic.

As of March 16 (00:00) citizens of the Czech Republic and foreigners with permanent residence or temporary residence of over 90 days are forbidden to travel from the Czech Republic with the exception of exempted persons.

Moreover, the Government of the Czech Republic adopted a number of other measures effective from March 16 (00:00) to April 1 (06:00) including free movement limitation with the exception of traveling to and from work and necessary travels to ensure basic human needs (e.g. food, pharma shopping, helping older family members).

Nevertheless, the current situation does not directly affect the operation of KRÁLOVOPOLSKÁ, a.s. and we would like to assure you that we are putting all our efforts into meeting all contractual deadlines. We will inform you immediately if the situation changes.
